truth, and that this subjective truth should be treated with the same weight and
consideration as objective truth.
 The problem with Relativism: the Law of Noncontradiction
 The law of noncontradiction says that "no two opposite statements
can both be at the same time in the same sense." -
Norman Geisler
 A relativist has to superimpose subjective truth over objective
reality
 To deny the law of noncontradiction is to deny all
itself and to embrace absurdity.
