## Old Humanity vs. New Humanity

- **Colossians 2:20-3:4**

- 2:20- If with Christ you \_\_\_\_\_...
- 3:1- If then you have been \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ...
- Now you have two \_\_\_\_\_ sets of desires at war within you.

- **Already/Not Yet**

- "For now, Christians live in a great theological tension: we already possess every spiritual blessing in Christ, but we do not experience the fullness of these blessings yet." – David Briones
- What is \_\_\_\_\_ ours, but \_\_\_\_\_ in our possession
- If you died with Christ, then be \_\_\_\_\_ to false teaching, if you raised with Him, be \_\_\_\_\_ to truth.

- **"Seek the things that are above"**

- More than just *thinking* on them... It's concentrating on them, focusing on them.
- Believers are to orient their entire life around the \_\_\_\_\_ of the heavenly kingdom and \_\_\_\_\_ out of those values.
- "We are not to strive for a "heavenly" status, since that has already been freely given us in Christ. Rather, we are to make that heavenly status the guidepost for all our thinking and acting." – Douglas Moo

- **The Source of Satisfaction**

- Colossians 3:5-11
- You can't say Jesus is Lord over everything in creation \_\_\_\_\_ for my life.
- Transformation is not the \_\_\_\_\_ of receiving new life, it's the \_\_\_\_\_ of a new life received.
- Transformation begins when I shift my source of \_\_\_\_\_ from the things of this world to the things of the Kingdom

- **The Things of the Kingdom**

- Colossians 3:12-15
- The Christian life is \_\_\_\_\_ by a consistent willingness to do the difficult thing.
- Paul invites these Colossian believers (and us) into Christ-like character.
- Colossians 3:16-17
  - Let the word of Christ dwell in you \_\_\_\_\_
  - Teach and admonish one another
  - Sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual \_\_\_\_\_
  - Be thankful (x2)
  - In everything you do, represent \_\_\_\_\_

## Practical Implications

- **In The Home**

- Colossians 3:18-21
- Renewed wives don't compete for \_\_\_\_\_, they submit to their husbands
- Renewed husbands don't \_\_\_\_\_ over their wives, they love them.
- Renewed children shouldn't be \_\_\_\_\_, but obedient.
- Renewed fathers shouldn't provoke and discourage, but calm and \_\_\_\_\_

- **In The Workplace**

- Colossians 3:22-4:1
- Renewed bondservants are not dishonestly \_\_\_\_\_, they are sincerely obedient
