

- John 14:10-14
  - Pray (Supplication)
  - o What do I see? (Observation)
    - Where is the text in salvation history?
    - What is the genre?
    - What is the historical situation/who is the audience?
    - What immediately precedes/proceeds this text?
  - What does it mean? (Interpretation)
  - What of this text is prescriptive/descriptive? (Principlization)
  - What is its point? (Application)
  - Pray (Supplication)
